Secretaries Report

- Secretary report was read from the July meeting and approved.

Treasurers Report

- Treasurer's report was read and approved with the following transactions.

 - \$500.00 from Aerotow, \$60.00 income from Fun Fly food donations

Old Business

- Update on the clubs 2nd Fun Fly of the year was held, we had around 10 pilots and good weather for the day.
- An email was sent out to all members inviting them to join the members on Groupme which is an app used to communicate between members. It is being utilized to send a message to other members if they are heading to the field to fly or work. We have about 10 current members in the group.

New Business

- Missing equipment report was utilized for Dick's F14. It flew out of sight when communication was lost. It went south with about $\frac{3}{4}$ tank of fuel and a slight climb. If you are driving to Iowa via Hope keep an eye open for it. Also it was used for a sail plane during the Aero-Tow. No luck at this point of locating the plane.
- The club had many compliments on the condition of the field for the Aero-Tow. They had in the mid 20's for a pilot count. Weather was only an issue for a small part of the event.

- A motion was made and approved to again sponsor the 4H Aerospace award this year for the Steele County Free Fair. Cost was \$25.00.

- The Civil Air Patrol Fly In Breakfast is scheduled for August 26th from 7:00AM to 12:00PM. We have a static display again this year and will start setting up at 6:00 – 6:30 roughly. We will again have a simulator available for people to try their hand at flying RC.

- All field maintenance equipment is in working order at meeting time. More discussion will be held at a future meeting on the possible purchase of new mowing equipment.
