Secretaries Report

- January minutes were read and approved

Treasurers Report

- Treasurer's report was read and approved with the following transactions.
 - Expenses –\$45.72 to Neil for sign lettering and web domain name
 - Income - \$350.00 from dues

Old Business

- The Home & Rec show is a go as long as the pricing comes in the same as last year.
- The field lease proposal was discussed . Events will be 2 - club fun fly's, 1- Heli event and 1 -Aero-Tow.
 - We are limiting the outside events to 2 per year
 - If an additional event is to be added it will need to be brought before the club to approve.
 - 20 or less pilots or event financial issues could be cause to cancel an event.
 - All Non ORCM events must be sanctioned and a contest director must be designated. This will hopefully create a better turnout for the events.
 - All event rates will be negotiated.
 - ORCM can add an event to promote the club and the hobby.
 - \$200.00 base fee plus \$15.00 fee per pilot up to \$450.00. Capped at \$650.00 total
- The above lease proposal will be sent to the glider and heli groups prior to the next meeting for use on the 2017 events.

New Business

- MRCSS Aero-Tow has requested the dates of July 13 – 16 for this year's event.
 - They would like to look at more space in the pits. We will discuss with them options they may have or what we may suggest but we would request they add labor to assist with any projects.
- The Husky is having slippage issues again in the hydrostatic drive and will not idle down when hot. We will look at it in the spring to see what options we may have.
- Fun Fly – Need to get a flyer together to send out to area clubs and also to hand out at the Home & Rec show.
 - Dates for the fun fly's are:
 - Fun Fly #1 June 3 with the 4th as a rain date,
 - Fun Fly #2 July 29 with the 30th as a rain date
 - Aero-Tow = July 13 – 16
 - Rotary Ringout = ???
- Home and Rec show dates March 24 – 26
 - Dale will check on using a TV again this year from Karl's TV & Appliance
