Secretaries Report

- May minutes were read and approved.

Treasurers Report

- Treasurer's report was read and approved with the following transactions.
 - Income – \$80.00 from new member dues
 - Expenses –\$24.70 for fuel. \$34.00 for more fuel, \$41.33 Belts for Alice.

Old Business

- Roofing will cost \$250.00 plus shingles and disposal. The job will be done on a Saturday
