Secretaries Report

- Secretary report was read from the May meeting and approved.

Treasurers Report

- Treasurer's report was read and approved with the following transactions.
 - Income - \$135.00 from dues
 - Expenses -Neil - \$85.89 2nd box of staples, \$50.00 landfill for fabric disposal,\$32.48 roller rental, \$25.21 food for runway install lunch (\$193.59 pay Neil 185.00 donating \$8.59 balance. \$53.54 to Dick for 2nd set of Ford Mower blades.

Old Business \$

- AMA Grant -We did not receive the requested \$655.91from the AMA for the purchase of the Cub Cadet mower. Too many applications this year and not enough money to cover them all. We will try again to apply again next year.
- 2020 Summer Event schedule –
 - June 27 Fun Fly #1
 - Aero-Tow July 9 – 12
 - July 25 Fun Fly #2 – We will make this fun fly date into an Aviation day event.
 - 3D Fest Aug 20 – 23
- Neil has had contact with both rental events and as of now they are still planning on holding the events with the current Covid 19 status.
- The website was updated with the 2020 Gold status as a leader club.
- Dick has 2 pilot stations built and installed with pilots liking being closer to the planes and runway for the depth perception.
- It was decided to not look at putting in an RC track since Blooming Prairie has the approval to put one in. No need for competition.

New Business

- Runway is installed but we want to install some of the old material at the North end of the runway. The Aero-tow would like the extra length for the tow planes. We will look next year to see if we want to add new material to the north end to finish the runway with good new material. To be discussed at a winter meeting.
- Fun Fly #1 is on June 27th. Start at 9:00 AM but we will not supply food or drink for this event due to Covid 19. Bring your own food and beverage if you plan to attend. Rain date on the 28th.
- Field Maintenance
 - Discussed if you have time to mow or trim please do your part to help with the field maintenance. An hour here or there helps to keep the field flyable for everyone.
 - The sheds need to have the final painting door to the doors and trim. Paint should be available if you have time.

- Neil to replace the 2 pieces of siding that blew off the sheds over the winter.
 - We need to spray the field when conditions are favorable to spray.
- Neil to send an update to the AMA on the install of the new runway fabric. Will get a few overhead pictures to send with the update.
