Secretaries Report

- Secretary report was read from the April meeting and approved.

Treasurers Report

- Treasurer's report was read and approved with the following transactions.
 - \$115.44 to Dick for Tank and fittings, \$119.44 to Brian for paint and fuel, \$119.65 to Neil for the drag, \$122.83 to Dick for chemical, \$69.70 for gutters.
 - \$193.00 for property taxes due May 15th.

Old Business

- Field Lease Agreements - received the signed agreement from the 3D group. Both events are set to go.

New Business

- The club has a place to hold the winter meetings again. We are scheduled for the Gainey room at the Owatonna Public Library again this winter. Meetings will start at 6:30 but will need to be completed by 8:00PM which is the new close time on Wednesdays. We are reserved the months of October – April.
- Dale went over the field safety rules for the season update per AMA safety rules.
- The Fun Fly dates have been set for the 2018 season. Rain dates will be the day after.
 - Fun Fly #1 – June 23rd 2018 & Fun Fly #2 – July 21st 2018
- The application for the 2018 Gold Leader status has been sent in. We have been approved again for the 2018 season.
- An update on special rule for model aircraft Section 336 was held. The rule was passed with some items the AMA would like to see changed but most items are AMA approved.
- Field projects for the spring. List hanging in the shed.
 - Drag was purchased to level the ground.
 - Doors on the large shed need to be replaced and painted this spring.
 - Aerotow group will be involved with changing the safety fence area for the large sail planes.
 - Skunk trap was set and 1 skunk was caught. No others have been caught since the first one.
 - Tables and signage have been set up.
 - A new roller was approved to purchase but it was decided that the old one would work sufficiently.
 - Dick updated us on the turf repair status: Sprayed the crabgrass chemical in the by the runway, pits and sheds. Grub control will take place in July after the hatch. Water tank is in and 110 gallons came in the first rain to fill it. Will rent the seeder for 2 days and the total cost will be closer to \$600.00.
 - Both blowers need the primer bulbs replaced, new bulbs are on the shelf in the large shed.

- Thursday night is club flying night again this year. Please try to come out to fly on this night for more visibility to the public.
- Big Thank You to Brian Monson for scrapping and painting both sheds this spring. It was brought up that we should look at putting permanent siding on the sheds before the wood is rotten. We could do one shed this year and one shed next year. More discussion towards end of the summer flying season.
