 - Spray the field around May 10th roughly to kill the weeds that are taking over.
 - Dirt and seed on the east side of the runway to level out the low spots.
 - Pull out the rock and trim around the sign by the gate for easier maintenance.
 - North end of runway redo the main runway material, old material is the best of the old runway and is failing. Also redo the taxiway on the north end.

- The sheds were reorganized to get both tractors in the small shed to open the large shed as a warming house for Jan 1st.
- New fire extinguishers were donated to the field. The old one may need recharging.
- A Notice of Renewal was received for the gravel pit south of the field.
- Meetings through March will now be held at HyVee due to the darkness and cold weather. See what April looks like in 2026.
